*Thank you for hosting me to teach an Open Centered Riding® Clinic at your facility. Enclosed please find all you will need to promote a successful clinic.*

*Two of the most commonly asked questions for these clinics are, “What is Centered Riding?” and “Who should attend?” I have enclosed information that helps explain what Centered Riding is all about. The answer to the second question is a simple one. Any horse enthusiast searching for a more natural, understanding and compassionate way to communicate with their horse should attend. These clinics are designed for riders of any age, discipline and ability. The focus is on the rider and how they affect their horse. Therefore, the participating horses need only be quiet and safe.*

*All of the forms enclosed can be photo copied to serve your needs. The flyers have a spot to fill out the date, location and host contact information. A black marker works best for that. I will also help promote your clinic by listing it on my website and Centered Riding’s website. I have enclosed a sample registration form for your use or you can create your own. I will need a completed liability form at the beginning of the clinic for each participant. I can make these forms available via e-mail if you prefer.*

*The clinic day will begin at 9:00 and end around 5:30. The end time depends on the number of participants. I will allow up to 12 participants and unlimited auditors. We will spend each morning learning without horses. This will require a space big enough for everyone to sit, as well as move around during interactive partner exercises.*

*The afternoons are spent applying what we have learned under saddle. We will have 2-3 group rides consisting of approximately 75 minutes per group. The host site generally provides lunch. Please let participants know if it will be provided or if they should bring one.*
